

2008 WSQHA Trophy Circuit

General Show Rules for May & July Shows

PRE-ENTRIES A pre-entry constitutes an entry that is faxed or mailed to include the correct entry blank filled out entirely; a copy of the registration papers; a copy of all current memberships of all exhibitors associated with this horse. **Entries are not accepted by phone or email. Entries are not accepted on notebook paper, napkins, etc...** One horse per entry. Incomplete entries may be charged the post entry fee regardless of when it is received. **EXCEPTIONS;** if your membership is expired you may purchase one at the show. Please include a note that you intend to do so.

STALLS RESERVATIONS A stall reservation form is included with this show bill. The stall reservation must be filled out in its entirety, with a list of horse if it is for a trainer, and payment in full. **Stalls are not guaranteed if payment is not included.**

RV HOOK UPS / CAMPING The Fairgrounds is responsible for all RV and camping arrangements. They will come around to collect the money. For more information please contact the Fairgrounds at (360) 805-6700.

DOGS, Per Fairground Rules; NO dogs allowed on the fairgrounds. They must be secured to RV or trailer in outside parking areas only. **Violators may be subjected to a fine of \$ 25.00 per incident.**

SKATEBOARDS, SCOOTERS, BICYCLES, Per Fairground Rules; NO rollerblades, skateboards, bicycles, scooters or other vehicles allowed on the fairgrounds. Handicapped permits may be issued at Fairgrounds office for assistance vehicles. **Violators may be subjected to a fine of \$ 25.00 per incident.**

ALL AROUND HIGH POINT AWARDS High points are calculated on one horse/one rider combination. The combo must show to all four judges. **EXCEPTION:** Open Horse can have multiple handlers. You must show in your corresponding halter class to be eligible for High Point Awards **EXCEPT 10 & Under, Novice youth & Novice amateur. SIGN UP IN THE OFFICE PRIOR TO THE FIRST CLASS OF YOUR DIVISION.** Sign up will not be allowed after a qualifying class within your division has ran. All horses competing for the high point all around award must enter their respective halter classes. Futurity classes not to count for any high point all around award. To be eligible for all-around award, a horse must compete in at least three classes (events) in one division (english or western open, amateur, youth, select or novice) in three or more categories. Points to be awarded as shown below. Ties will be broken in the following manner: 1) the horse who earned points in the greatest number of events 2) the horse winning over the greatest number of horses 3) the horse earning the most points in performance events will be declared the winner. Must show under all four judges competing in all four shows to qualify for an award. High points are calculated on one horse/one rider combination. The combo must show to all four judges. **EXCEPTION:** Jr Horse & Sr Horse can have multiple handlers. Any changes or corrections in High Point class criteria will be posted at the show. Show office will post qualifying classes at the show. **HIGH POINT AWARD WINNERS WILL BE ANNOUNCED APPX 30 MINUTES AFTER THE FINAL QUALIFYING CLASS**

WALK TROT CLASSES, 10 & Under Classes are non-AQHA open classes. Walk Trot exhibitors may not cross enter with AQHA classes **INCLUDING** showmanship & halter.

ADDS & SCRATCHES, you will not be charged for class scratches **PROVIDING** you scratch in the office 2 classes prior to the said class. While scratching at the gate is an appreciated courtesy, it **WILL NOT** relieve you of the financial responsibility of the class if you have not made the office aware.

PERFORMANCE HALTER You must provide proof of eligibility of ROM in order to participate in **PERFORMANCE HALTER** in each **OPEN, AMATEUR** and **YOUTH.**

MEMBERSHIP : ANYONE wanting to show must possess and show a current AQHA membership card to the secretary at time of entry. Memberships may be purchased at the office. An internet receipt is not acceptable. Faxed copies will be accepted with faxed entry.

NOVICE CLASSES: available to an Amateur or Youth rider who meet eligibility per Official 2007 AQHA Rule Book.

REGISTRATION PAPERS must be presented to the secretary at time of entry. Faxed copies will be accepted with faxed entry

BE AWARE : All exhibitors are responsible for any fines levied against the show caused by exhibitors. See Rule No. 414c in 2007 AQHA handbook.

Refund of Entries Fees for AQHA classes with Veterinarian Certificate presented to the show office, **ONLY Before the Show Starts.** There is a \$ 30 office charge for each canceled entry.

Refund of Stall Fees are with Veterinarian Certificate presented to the show office, **ONLY Before the Show Starts.** There is a \$ 30 office charge for each canceled stall.

Awards to Six Places, in ALL Classes.

If **paraphernalia** is left in a stall assigned to you, you will be charged the fine of \$ 100.00

AQHA/NRCHA/NSBA rules will prevail in respective classes, judges' decisions are final. Anything not covered by the general rules or the Association rulebook will be at the discretion of show committee.

DRUG TESTING, Horses entering AQHA classes will be subject to approved drug testing.

DRAWS, All draws will be made two classes ahead of time. Entries accepted until the class begins. All entries after the draw will be placed last on the draw.

CATTLE, JULY SHOW ONLY Cattle must be reserved no later than June 28, 2008. Any cancellations after July 3rd, the owner of the horse will be charged for the cattle fee.
